## BADN OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTION TO DENTAL NURSING AWARD 2017

### NOMINATION GUIDELINES

1. The BADN Outstanding Contribution to Dental Nursing Award is awarded to a person deemed by BADN Executive Committee to have made an outstanding contribution to the development and/or support of the dental nursing profession.
2. Anyone may nominate – all nominations must be on the official nomination form and all nominations must reach the Chief Executive at the email address above by midday on the stated closing date. Nominations may be sent by post if necessary, but e-mail is preferred.
3. The person nominated should be a Registered Dental Nurse.
4. The Award is for an outstanding contribution to the dental nursing profession – ie to dental nursing as a whole, not to a specific practice, clinic, college, etc. The contribution should have had a notable impact nationwide (either UK-wide, or across one of the home countries, eg England, Scotland, Wales, N. Ireland) and have been to the benefit of the dental nursing profession generally, not just a specific sector. Nominators are asked to write a short narrative on the impact they believe their nominee's contribution has made, showing how their contribution has advanced dental nursing, at what level, who has benefited in terms of: individuals, including both peers as well as patients; organisations; the profession; or more widely in terms of the whole dental community (nationally and internationally) and how the group(s) have benefitted.
5. The nominee's contribution should have been above and beyond the remit of their paid employment – nominations for those who are merely fulfilling the requirements of their paid employment, however admirably, will not be considered.
6. All eligible nominations will be considered by BADN Executive Committee who will decide whether, and to whom, the Award should be given. In the absence of any suitable nominations, BADN Executive Committee may decide not to present the award. The decision of BADN Executive Committee is final. Should any of the Executive Committee be nominated, they will not form part of the judging panel - the Executive Committee may co-opt other BADN members onto the judging panel at their discretion to replace any nominated Executive Committee members.
